Your Cedar Wood Duck House Plan



Actual Size
Wood Duck &
Hooded Merganser
Entrance Hole

(3½" x 4½" – Goldeneyes) (2½" Circle – Bufflehead)

SAFETY TIPS:


- 1. SAFETY GLASSES should be worn by EVERYONE in the woodworking area.
- 2. ADULTS should closely supervise the use of all tools. POWER SAWS should involve "hands on" adult supervision if not actual COMPLETION BY AN ADULT.

LUMBER:

- 1. Use "grade 3" cedar, rough one side.
- 2. Sides/front/back/floor 1" x 10" (actual ³/₄" x 9¹/₄").
- 3.Roof -1"x 12" (actual $\frac{3}{4}$ " x $11\frac{1}{4}$ ").
- 4. Rough surface goes OUT on completed house. (One "side" will be smooth unless you make an even number of houses and alternate the direction of your cross cut.)

DRAWING DETAILS:

* Drain holes are NOT recommended in this house design.



FINAL CONSIDERATIONS:

- 1. Have you attached your 1/4" mesh EXIT LADDER? (A staple gun works great!)
- 2. Have you added 4" of cedar shavings as a nest base material?
